Content Management Is Queen!

SMALL BUSINESS CONVENTION presented by COSE

Circa 1995 ...

- Content map lived outside the server
- Content changes implemented by humans
- Repetitive, labor-intensive, error-prone



Circa 2005 ...

- Rise of proprietary content management systems
- Integration with databases
- Greatly reduced repetitive human effort and human error
- BUT: licensing fees, slow development, 'hostage content'



- Circa 2014 ... the Open Source revolution
 - Your content truly yours ... runs anywhere
 - Crowd-sourced evolution
 - Communitarian culture



- What are the best practices for small business, in light of shifts in CM over time?
 - Most manageable
 - Least effort
 - Most sustainable, long-term

- David vs. Goliath

- Nimbleness WITH focus wins
